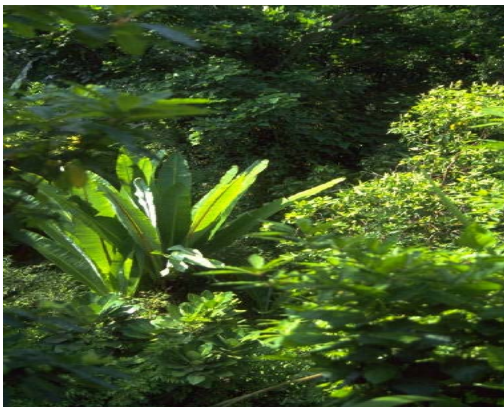

## Coastal Region
