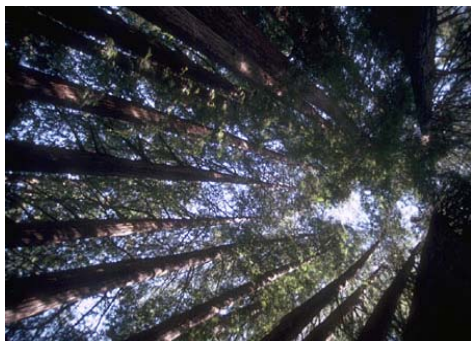
Low rainfall especially during growing season.

Coastal

Elevation

0-2,500 feet

Climate

Mild temperature summer fog 130-240 inches of rain per year.

Location

All along the Washington coast .

Native Trees

Douglas-fir, Western red cedar, Western hemlock, Sitka spruce, Grand fir, Pacific yew, Red alder, Black cottonwood, Big leaf maple, Lodge pole pine,



Lowland

Elevation

0-2,500 feet

Climate

Mild temperature 40-70 inches pf rain per year

Location

From Oregon to Canada 1-5 goes through it

Native Trees

Douglas-fir, Western red cedar, Western hemlock, Sitka spruce, Grand fir, Pacific yew, Red alder, Black cottonwood, Bid leaf maple, Oregon white oak,



Mountain

Elevation

2,500-7,000 feet

Climate

Short cool growing season.

70-110 inches of rain per year, with much falling as snow.

Location

Mid-elevations in cascade and Olympic Mountain ranges.

Native Trees

Douglas-fir, Western red cedar, Western hemlock, Mountain hemlock, Pacific yew, Pacific silver fir, Noble fir, Sub alpine Western white pine, Alaska yellow cedar
